




## HILLSMEADE VISION STATEMENT

As of 2016 schools do not need parents permission for students to take part in the reading challenge so as a school we will be registering each child and we strongly encourage students to complete the Challenge.

As you can imagine it will take a little while to register all students so we ask you to bear with us for a little while until we can complete this task. Your child will soon be issued with a User Name and Password so that they can enter the books they have read. In the meantime please keep a record of the title and author of the books that have been read. The Challenge is for children to read a set number of books by 9 September 2016. All children who meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier. If you would like your child's name to appear on the Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge online Honour Roll, please sign this form and return it to your school by the end of june.

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## **Privacy Protection**
