Our school is continuing to prosper for our local community children. School Council recently approved the installation of an additional playground for the senior students as a result of the dedicated work of our HFC members. Children's toilet floors and new carpet for our Library and office administration area are also being quoted. It is anticipated that work will commence on these shortly. All grades recently received new computers and iPads for student use. Staff have developed an Instructional Model to ensure a consistent approach to teaching and we are trialling this in our reading sessions. All teachers will be involved in observations and modelling of this model as part of our evidence based professional learning program. It is an exciting time for Hillsmeade PS with an enrolment figure today of 912 students (844 in 2014; 854 in 2015).


