Functions of a school council

The functions of a school council are outlined in the Education and Training Reform Act 2006 and include:

- establishing the broad direction and vision of the school within the school's community
- participating in the development and monitoring of the school strategic plan
- approving the annual budget and monitoring expenditure
- developing, reviewing and updating school policies
- raising funds for school-related purposes
- maintaining the school's grounds and facilities
- entering into contracts (such as for cleaning or construction work)
- reporting annually to the school community and to the Department
- creating interest in the school in the wider community
- informing itself of and taking into account the views of the community
- regulating and facilitating the after hours use of school premises and grounds
- operating a children's service at the school or other premises controlled by the Minister.

School Banking – Every Tuesday

FAQ:

How do I open a Commonwealth Bank account?

Either online (commbank.com.au/schoolbanking) or in person at any Commonwealth Bank branch.

What day is banking day?

Every Tuesday during the school term.

Do I have to bank every week?

No, however if you make at least 15 deposits (any amount) before the end of term 3, you will be automatically be entered into the draw to win a family trip to Tokyo Disneyland.

I already have a Commonwealth Bank account, can I start banking through the school?

Yes, just send your bank account details in an envelope to the school and we will issue you a yellow school bank book, a folder and a student number.

I've lost my bank book, can I still bank?

Yes, we can easily replace your bank book.

What is a banking token?

Each time you make a deposit you will be given a banking token. When you have 10 tokens you can redeem them for a reward item.

I didn't get given a banking token when I made a deposit, can I get one please?

Yes, just write us a little note the following week and we'll give you the token. Sometimes we forget to pop them in the bank

book. The computer automatically records how many tokens each banker has so if you lose your tokens or don't get given them all it doesn't matter. You can still order the reward items.

How to I redeem my banking tokens?

Every student was given a banking information leaflet with the reward items available and how to redeem them at the beginning of the year. If you need a new copy, collect one from the office. Each term there are 2 new items to redeem. You cannot redeem an item before it is released. After it's release you can redeem an item in any subsequent term (subject to availability).

Who do I give my bankbook to?

Hand it in to your classroom teacher or to the office before 11am on Tuesday to ensure your deposit is processed that week. Bank books received after 11am may not be processed until the following week

How do I ask any other questions?

There is a communication book at the office where you can leave messages for us. We will get back to you within one week.


