#### **UNSW ICAS Testing**



## **Digital Technology Update**

In 2017 Hillsmeade has continued to develop our digital technology resources. Currently, each classroom P-4 is equipped with 3 x notebooks and 6 x IPADs. The 5/6 classrooms are equipped with 6 x notebooks and 6 x IPADs. In Term 2 we will be rolling out an additional 3 x notebooks per P-4 classroom.

This complements our Year 5/6 Managed Laptop Program that provides opportunities for students in the senior school to purchase their own device through the school supplier.

All classrooms are now equipped with Apple TVs that allow the wireless interaction between the classroom TV and the IPADs.

The school is currently in the process of upgrading our current cabling system to the classroom portables with fibre optical cabling that will further improve our IT infrastructure.

The education department has also committed funds to all schools in Victoria to further enhance the Wi-Fi capabilities in schools. This funding will be in the form of supplying additional wireless access points that will be installed in classrooms.

A. Some activities have electronic forms attached that need to be or prior to making the payment for the item. It is important to ensure you complete the form, you also complete the payment step.

- To complete a form and the payment:

  1. Open Okrl

  2. Select the activity that you are purchasing and 'Add to cart'.

  3. Tap 'Ok' when prompted for additional information.

  4. Enter your Okr password to sign in to the form then complete the information as required. Fields with a red asterisk (\*) are mandatory to be completed.

  5. Sign the form if required and tap Next or Submit when complete to add the activity and form to the cart.
- Tap Checkout at the bottom of the screen to display your order summary
- showing that there is a form attached. 7. Tap 'Confirm & Pay' and submit the payment.
