Leading Literacy for Networks

Over the course of semester 1, I have been attending professional learning workshops to continue my growth as a literacy teacher and to develop my skills as a 'Master Trainer'.

Last week, Jess McKnight (River Gum PS) and I delivered our first workshop to 21 teachers from across the Casey Central Network.

The aim of our workshops is to build teacher's capacity to lead literacy teaching and learning within their own schools. This first workshop focused on exploring current research relating



to the teaching and learning of reading, as well as effective Professional Learning Communities (known at Hillsmeade as PLT's).

The group of teachers in attendance demonstrated a high level of passion and dedication to improving teacher knowledge and skill in literacy teaching and to enhancing student engagement in reading and growth in learning.

This is an excellent opportunity for our network of schools, particularly for us at Hillsmeade! I have been fortunate to be working with a variety of literacy experts and am so excited to share my learning and to continue driving student learning in literacy at Hillsmeade!

GR 5 INDIGENOUS GUEST SPEAKER

On Thursday 19th July Shilo and Zoe came to talk to the year 5 students and teachers about the importance of Indigenous people and how they are related to the land. We learnt that there are over 500 Aboriginal languages. Many tribes would come together to share and trade their resources. To hunt, they would farm, spear kangaroos and get food from different animals and plants. They could even catch eels using traps.

Everyone only took what they needed and respected each tribes' land. When the settlers came, the Indigenous people were ordered to move from their land and not speak their language. However, now they are trying to rediscover their languages and culture to live as who they are.

Thank you to Shilo and Zoe for sharing and teaching the Year 5's about the Indigenous culture.

If students and families are interested in learning more about the Indigenous culture, visit the Bunjilaka Aboriginal Cultural Centre at Melbourne Museum.
