- What do you think the **Authors Purpose** for this book is? To entertain, to inform or to persuade?





#### Read 'Meteors' pages 10-19










\*hint\* The first or last sentence can give you a clue.

Effect is what happens after that something happens.




What connections can you make after reading this book?






Some more activities if you choose...
