Remember to use your prompt sheet


Learning Intention: To make connections between the text and their own life.

The seasons are Summer, Autumn, Winter and Spring. Think about your favourite season of the year.





Draw a picture of what clothes you would wear and write about what you like to do in that season.



Share it with an adult.



DAY 2

Learning Intention: To understand the problem and the solution in the text.



Listen to the book again.



Read to an adult.

Mole tried to wake Bear up. He tried many different ways.

How would you wake up someone in your family? Is there a funny way to wake someone up?





Draw a funny way to wake someone up. **Write** a sentence about your drawing.



Talk to an adult about your picture and writing.

DAY 3

Learning Intention: Infer what a character is like from the story.



Listen to the book again.



Read the book to someone in your family.



Look through the book and take notice of what Mole does. Pay close attention to his face and his body,



how might he be feeling? Are his actions positive? What does Bear think of Mole?





Write words about him. Describe Mole as a character – not just what he looks like but as a friend,



Share this with an adult.
