Learning Intention: To listen to the book about rainforests and learn about the animals that live there.



Listen to the book.



Read along with an adult.



Copy a favourite picture from the book and tell an adult why you chose it.



Talk to an adult about what you read.

DAY 2

Learning Intention: To identify verbs in the text.



Listen to the book again.



Read to an adult.



This is a **non fiction** book. It is a book that gives information about a topic. This book looks at the different animals found in a rainforest and how they

move. These movement words are called **verbs** They are **action words**.

Stand up and move your body. What actions did you do with your body?



Can you move like a kangaroo? What is that action called?





Share your list with an adult and see if you can add some more verbs.



DAY 3

Learning Intention: To understand a visual map.



Listen to the book again.



Read the book to someone in your family.



The Rain Forest Map shows where particular animals live around the world. The **Map Key** shows where the tropical rainforests are in the world.



Around the map you can see animals.

Find out where 3 of the animals live and write them in your book.



Share with an adult.



DAY 4



Some more activities if you choose...

Learning Intention: Show your understanding of rainforests.

Choose one or more of these activities:

Walk in your garden and see if you can see some creepy crawlies.

Ask a parent if you can photograph them. How do they move?

What verbs could you use to describe the way it moves?

Write a story about a rainforest adventure. Describe the adventure and the animals you might see.

Research a rainforest animal and share the information with a family member.
