DAY 2





Listen to the book again.



Read to an adult.

This is a non-fiction book. It gives information about penguins. Throughout the book there are words in **bold**. These words are found in the back of the book in the **glossary**. It tells you what the word means and also has a photo.



Look at the picture you drew yesterday. Use the words **flipper** and **webbed** to **label** the picture you drew. Add a **heading** to your drawing. Can you label any other parts of the penguin?



Share your picture with an adult. .

DAY 3



Learning Intention: To ask questions to enhance your own understanding of a topic.



Read the book to someone in your family.



Think about what you have learnt about penguins.

On page 20 the author asks the question, have you seen a penguin?

Think about what you know about penguins. What new information would you like to know?



Write 3 questions about penguins in your book. Remember to add a ? at the end.



Share your questions with an adult.

DAY 4

Learning Intention: Show your understanding about the text



Create a diorama of a penguin in its environment.



Watch 'Happy Feet' with your family. How is the book like the movie.



Research penguins and make an information poster.



Write an adventure story where you find a penguin your backyard!
