- Listen to the text
- Log on to Epic using your class code

- Find a quiet place where you can hear clearly
- You need to be doing whole body listening

  use .?! "" (punctuation)
  sound out the words b-a-t



- Use a pencil to complete this task

#### DAY 2





#### Learning Intention: To use pictures and first sounds help work out words.



Listen to the book again.



Read to an adult.



Look at this page in your book.



Cody has grass in his mouth. Find the 'g' for grass.



Draw Cody eating meat. Write the sentence 'Cody eats meat'.



Ask an adult to help you look for different food in your pantry.

Can you find a food for every letter?





### DAY 3



Learning Intention: To notice that the pictures tell you how the characters are feeling.

Listen to the book again.

Read the book to someone in your family.

Look at this page.

Look at Cody's eyes. Do they tell you that Cody is happy?


Look at the cat's face. His face tells you he is angry. Why?

Look at Cody's eyes now. What do they tell you now?

Draw your face when you eat ice cream. Write about how you feel.

Look at the pages in your book. Ask an adult how Cody is feeling on each

page. Do you agree? How do you know?







## DAY 4



Some more activities if you choose...

Learning Intention: To show that you can use pictures to help you work out words.



Choose one or more of these activities:

Ask your family and friends what they like to eat and what they don't like.

Make a book with a different person on each page.



Write a sentence for each page. Mum eats \_\_\_\_\_.





Share your book with your family.

Does everyone like the same thing?




Ask an adult to help you find the story of 'Six Dinner Sid.'
