Learning Intention: To listen to and read the non-fiction book 'Ducklings'.

DAY 2



Look at this page from the book. It shows you the Index.

The **Index** is at the end of your book.

The Index tells you the page the information is on.

Look at the word 'egg'. Check that it is on page 6.



Check the other words and pages in the Index. Are they correct?

Choose a word from the Index. Find the word and copy the page.

Tell an adult what you know about the Index. Ask them to find another photo using the index.



DAY 3





Learning Intention: To learn about long and short 'E' sounds in words.

Listen to the book again.



- Read the book to someone in your family.
- Look at this page in your book.
- The letters e and a make different sounds in each of these words.
- EA makes a long sound in beak but a short sound in feathers.
- EE makes a long e sound in feet.

Knowing that vowels can have long or short sounds helps us read the words.



- Draw three circles. Sort these words from your book into the correct group. feathers need eat feel keep feel
- Tell an adult about the long and short e sounds.
- Ask them to help you find other long e words around your house or in another book.







Learning Intention: To show what information you learned about ducklings.

Choose one or more of these activities:



Make a non-fiction book. Write 3 interesting facts you learned about ducklings. Don't forget to make an index for the last page of your book.

Ask an adult to help you find a video or book about 'The Ugly Duckling.'

Tell an adult why you think this is a fiction or non-fiction book.



'Ducklings' is a non-fiction book about ducklings.

Write a fiction story that has a duckling as the main character, make it a different story to 'The Ugly Duckling.'
