In the story, Tina's Mum asks her to do things to stay safe while swimming.


Think about a time when a family member has reminded you to do

DAYZ




- Listen to the book.

 - Think about Tina and her Mum.




- Think about what is the same about them compare.

Learning Intention: Make connections to a story and your own life.

Write a list of steps you would take to keep yourself safe at the shops or when visiting a playground.

Create your own comic using speech bubbles.
