


Learning Intention: To use a variety of reading strategies when solving unknown words.



Before reading the book have a look at these 2 reading strategies.



Use your knowledge of letters and sounds to try and solve tricky words.







As you read through the book write down a list of words that you used these

strategies to solve.



Share your writing with an adult.

Learning Intention: To share your understanding of part of the text using your own words.



Listen to the book again.



Read to an adult.



On the page with the heading 'Helpful Tools' the author writes about different **tools** that people might use to see better.









Here are 4 different tools people use. Write as much information you can about one of these tools. The tools are called glasses, a magnifying glass, binoculars and a telescope.



Ask an adult if they know any more information about the tool you chose.

Learning Intention: To understand how to use a pronunciation guide.



Read the book to someone in your family.




One text feature found in a non-fiction book is a glossary. It is a

list of words and what they mean. The glossary in this book has a **pronunciation guide** beside each word. **Pronunciation** is the way a word is spoken.





Copy each word and how to pronounce it. Practise reading each of the words.

Choose one or more of these activities:

Answer the questions on page 21 called 'What did you learn?'

Use 'Chunky Monkey' and 'Flippy the Dolphin' to tackle other tricky words in different books.
