

book with them.





Now write your **summary** of the interesting part.

Choose one or more of these activities:




Create a list of other farm animals and write facts that you know. Research these animals and add an extra fact for each animals.




Research the process on how milk, cheese or yoghurt is made. Explain the process to a member of your family.
