
# **Teacher Professional Practice and Planning Days**

# FROM MR CARDAMONE

Good afternoon Hillsmeade,

I hope it has been a positive week so far for you and your families given the circumstances. Last week I shared some of the things we do at Hillsmeade to focus on Social and Emotional Learning and the mental health and wellbeing of our students, we had a close focus on circle time. This week, I wanted to share with you in more detail about the Zones of Regulation that Hillsmeade has implemented in every classroom. This has been a successful framework for our school and for our students to learn more about self-regulation and their emotions. We have seen many families implement the zones at home. I will share an overview of what are the zones and how they are implement in all classrooms. Over the next few weeks, I will discuss what each zone is and the meanings and strategies that may help your families and children.

The zones language is used every day in all classes to build emotional literacy and to support our students with strategies that they can use in each of the zones. At the start of the school year, the Zones of Regulation are unpacked through the positive Start Program and students have an opportunity to design and come up with strategies that they can use to support them to self-regulate. Please find some information on the zones from the official Zones of Regulation website below.

### What are the Zones?

The Zones is a systematic, cognitive behavioural approach used to teach self-regulation by categorizing all the different ways we feel and states of alertness we experience into four concrete coloured zones.

The Zones framework provides strategies to teach students to become more aware of and independent in controlling their emotions and impulses, manage their sensory needs, and improve their ability to problem solve conflicts." <a href="https://www.zonesofregulation.com">https://www.zonesofregulation.com</a>




