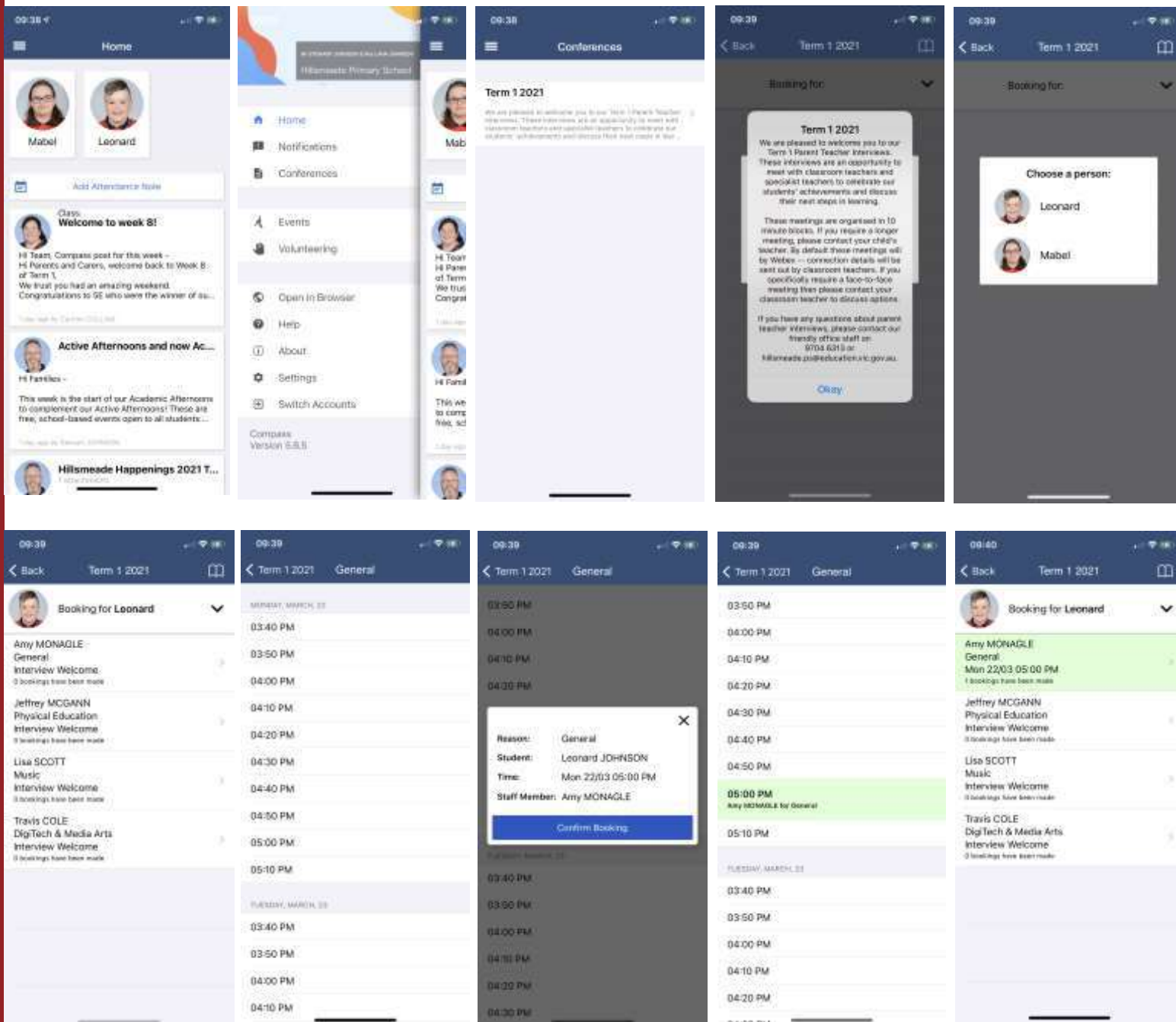
Thursday 25th March is a Free Dress Day by gold coin donation. This is a fundraiser for our Easter raffle (tickets are available for purchase).

I hope this week has been a positive one for you and your family. Last week I shared what the Zones of Regulation are and information about the yellow zone.

Don't forget breakfast club every Monday and Tuesday 8:15am-8:40am at the canteen

We have added a new item to breakfast club for next week. There will be canned peaches added that students can have in a bowl. Come and enjoy!!!

This week will be a focus on the red zone. The **Red Zone** is used to describe extremely heightened states of alertness and intense emotions. A person may be elated or experiencing anger, rage, devastation, or terror when in the red zone." <https://www.zonesofregulation.com/learn-more-about-the-zones.html>

We educate students to know, no zone is "bad" and that they are all normal feelings. We focus on strategies that can help us when we are in the Red zone. Although some strategies will work for us differently, there are some common strategies that work for lots of students when they feel in the Red zone, such as:

- Running
- Taking time to reflect
- Talking to trusted adults
- Breathing exercises
- Drinking water

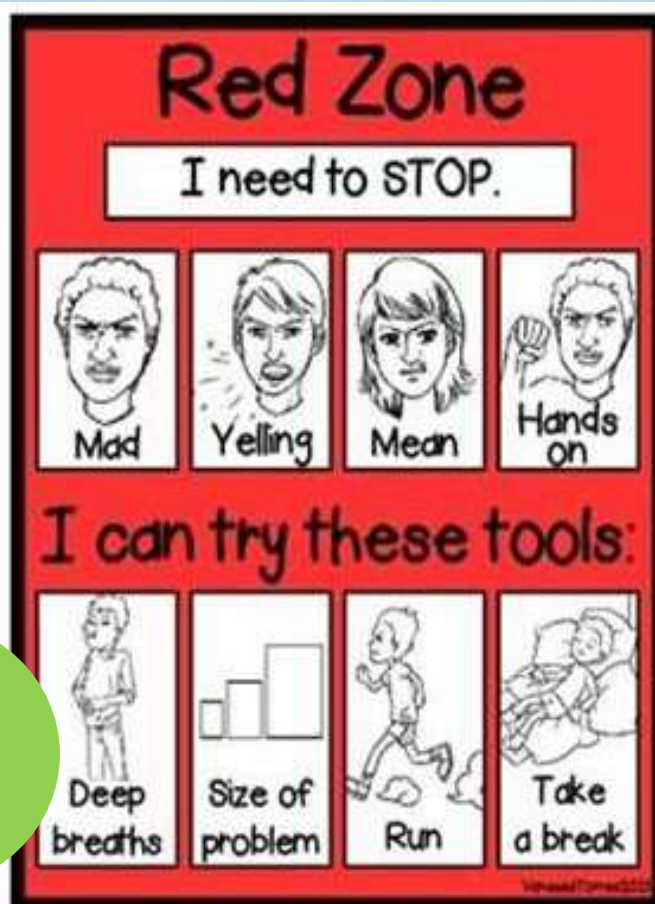
The zones language is used every day in all classes to build emotional literacy, the Zones of Regulation is unpacked through the positive Start Program and students have an opportunity to design and come up with strategies that they can use to support them to self-regulate. Please find some information on the zones from the official Zones of Regulation website below.

Goals of The ZONES Curriculum

Teaches students

- Identify their feelings and levels of alertness
- Understand their feelings in context
- Effective regulation tools
- When and how to use tools
- Problem solve positive solutions
- Understand how their behaviours influence others' thoughts and feelings

And ultimately move towards Independent Regulation

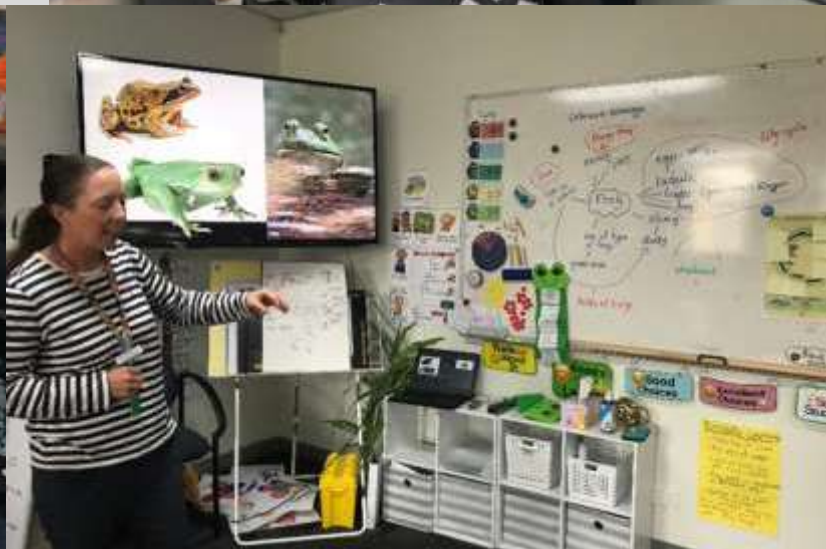


FULL STEAM AHEAD!

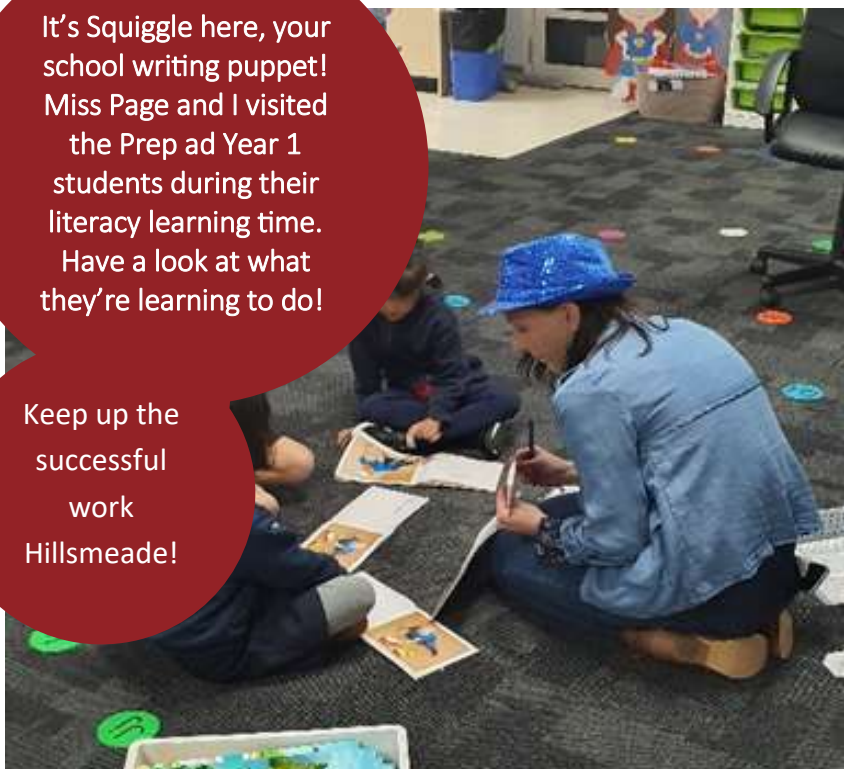

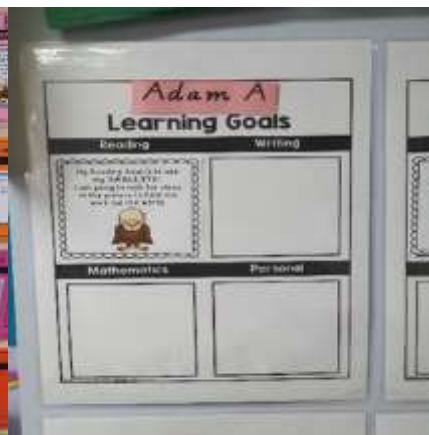
Learning to identify letters and sounds supports young readers and writers to develop phonological awareness. Ms Papa is showing her students how to stretch sounds to read words.

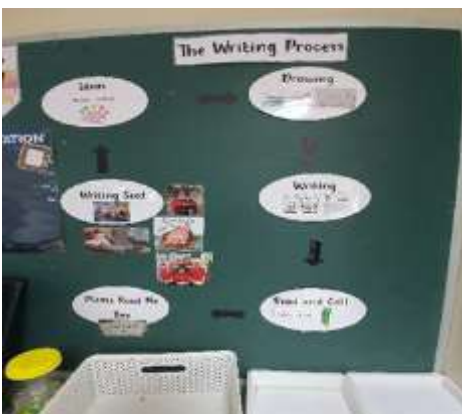
During literacy learning, students engage in a variety of engaging and hands-on independent learning activities. These allow learners to work towards their learning goal and practise what their teacher has taught them.

FROM THE SICKBAY

Good old-fashioned handwashing with soap and water is still the best defence against spreading gastroenteritis.

You can prevent the spread of gastroenteritis to other people if you:

Make sure everyone in the family washes their hands regularly, especially after toilet and before they eat.

Wash your child's hands with warm water and soap after they use the toilet and before and after they eat.

Wash your hands before you feed and after you change your child's nappies.

Clean kitchen tops, toys, toilet seats, nappy change tables and taps to ensure you don't spread the infection to others at home.

Keep your child away from others until 48 hours after their symptoms have stopped. If symptoms persist, visit your GP.

Don't allow your child to attend child care or school until 48 hours after their symptoms have stopped.

Teach your child good hand hygiene by showing them how to become a Soapy Hero!

Remember, washing hands with soap and water is the best way to prevent gastroenteritis infection. Alcohol-based hand sanitisers while effective against some viruses (such as coronavirus), are not effective against gastroenteritis.
