Learning Intention: To make predictions about a text using previous knowledge.



This book is called 'The Three Little Recyclers'. Have a look at the cover of the book. There are 3 pigs and a wolf in this story.

Think about what might happen in the story.



Make a **prediction** about what will happen with these characters.



Write your prediction and draw a picture.



Listen to the book.



Read along with an adult.

Was your prediction close to what happened in the story?



Learning Intention: To know what a character is like by looking at what they do and say.



Listen to the book again.




Read to an adult.

what he did? How would you describe the wolf?






Draw a picture of the wolf and write words describing him.

Share your work with an adult.











Listen to the book again.



Read the book to someone in your family.

Many action words have <u>-ed</u> on the end:



walk-ed

Not all action words end in -ed.



Most past tense verbs are formed by adding the 'ed' ending to the verb.

walk = walked play = played look = looked smile = smiled call = called open = opened



Look through the book and see if you can find words that have -ed at the end.



Talk to an adult about action words. Can you create a list of words that end in -ed?

Read another book that has 3 pigs in it. How is it the same as this story?
