Good morning Hillsmeade Primary School Community,

Thank you for your patience as we prepare for a move back into Remote Learning 2.0. We would like to acknowledge the efforts of Parents and Carers, students and staff throughout our first Remote Learning period and acknowledge that this is not an easy way in which to work.

Remote Learning Changes

Throughout last term we collected feedback on remote learning from students, parents and staff. As a school we are continuing to improve our approach based on this feedback as we move into remote learning in Term 3. This will include:

- Inclusion of teacher video content per lesson to support instruction.
- Utilising Webex for Year 3 Year 6 classes. This will involve a Monday and a Friday check in class Webex meeting, as well as a daily 12 noon – 12:30pm Webex time available for students to engage with their teachers and peers if in need of assistance.
- Daily learning plans to be more streamlined to include Reading, Writing and Mathematics.
- Specialist lessons and Science lessons will be available for students to access through the learning portal on our school website.
- Shared information and clarity around assessment expectations.
- Daily social and emotional learning (SEL) focus at the start of daily lesson plans, recorded by our SEL Leader Mr Cardamone.

The following students can attend school for on-site supervision, but will also undertake the remote learning program (there is no explicit teaching):


- Children of parents / carers who cannot make suitable arrangements to supervise children at home
