

## Casey School Crossing Supervisors are trained to help children cross the road safely.



- ☐ Use the School Crossing. It is the safest place for children and adults to cross the road. Be a role model to your children use the school crossing and your children will copy you.
- □ Stand behind the yellow line while waiting to cross no need to crowd, there will be plenty of time for everyone to cross.
- ☐ Walk between the lines as you cross, to keep a safe distance between you and cars
- ☐ Walk your bike or scooter across the crossing. Do not ride.
- ☐ Keep the School Crossing clear. Do not stop your car on the crossing. Blocking the crossing is not only against the law, but also dangerous for everyone.
- ☐ Be respectful to the School Crossing Supervisor, they are there for you.
